What Do We Mean By Common Ground?

- 1. If a **clear majority** of us in the region (city, state, country) agree upon an issue and its solution as proposed and developed into a policy directive directed to the appropriate legislators and executives that issue is part of our common ground.
- 2. Clear majority means that **something like 70% or more** are in agreement. 50% or so is not sufficient.
- 3. By **common ground** we mean the totality of issues where we, the people, have found such agreement.
